- 1. Notice has been given, through Reference D-F, of the NCI Agency's intent to request a solution for Asset, Configuration, Patching and Vulnerability (ACPV) Enterprise Service. National Authorities had been invited to provide "Declarations of Eligibility" of qualified and certified firms which may be interested in receiving the solicitation package for this requirement, no later than Monday, 31 October 2022.
- 2. By this Amendment 3, the Closing Date for Nominations of Firms by their National Authorities has been extended to Friday, 18 November 2022. Release of the solicitation package is anticipated to occur in Q4 2022.
- 3. Additionally, notice has been given, through Reference F, of the plan to conduct an Industry Day and that registration details would be provided via an Amendment to the NOI.
- 4. Industry Day is set to take place on Tuesday, 22 November 2022 beginning at 1500 and ending at 1700 Central European Summer Time (CEST).
- 5. Industry Day will be conducted virtually on a WebEx platform and interested firms shall register at: https://digitalworkplace.nato.int/PublicPages/IndustryDayRfs.aspx
 - a. Registrants will be required to provide the following information:
 - i. First and Last Name
 - ii. Official Job Title
 - iii. Contact information (e-mail and telephone number)
 - iv. Company Name and address
 - v. National Authority (Country Name)
 - vi. Status of DOE (Declaration of Eligibility) process



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- 6. If an interested firm has not obtained a completed DOE by the closing date, then the firm is encouraged to contact their National Authority and request an email is sent to the NCI Agency confirming a DOE process is underway and the firm is indeed able to attend Industry Day. Email must be sent to <u>RFS-CO-115699-ACPV@ncia.nato.int</u>.
- 7. The registration page will close on **Sunday**, **20 November 2022**. Therefore, the NCI Agency respectfully requests that representatives from each of the interested firms register for Industry Day in a timely manner.
