Proposed transition approach with a specific focus on the key transition components and continuity of service for all services

oProposed communication approach towards all customers for all services. Top 5 risks identified and their proposed mitigation based on past and similar experience for all services;

oDescription of the understanding of the applicable NATO Directives D24/D47/D48 for an existing solution that clearly identifies the areas of compliancy and non-compliancy with a high level planning on how the non-compliancy areas are to be addressed.

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3.5.2.2.3.The Proposed Approach for Network Services

3.5.2.2.3.1.The bidder shall deliver high level implementation plan including the following:

oProposed schedule / milestones, proposed discovery and build-up approach for all services, including bidders approach to maximize transferability of the solution to the Purchaser's ecosystem, i.e. minimization customization of the proposed solution. Proposed transition approach with a specific focus on the key transition components and continuity of service for all services

oProposed communication approach towards all customers for all services. Top 5 risks identified and their proposed mitigation based on past and similar experience for all services;

oDescription of the understanding of the applicable NATO Directives D30/D48 with a high level planning on how compliancy is to be addressed.
